The Galveston Bay Foundation will host its Houston Oyster & SeaFest from 11:30 AM – 2:30 PM on April 22, 2023 at The Water Works in Buffalo Bayou Park. **This festival is expecting up to 500 guests who will enjoy a variety of menu items from some of Houston's top restaurants.** Ticket prices range from \$35 for a regular ticket to \$150 for a VIP experience. This event serves as an introduction to our Oyster Shell Recycling Program. We are excited to highlight many of the restaurants we partner with currently, as well as raise funds to continue our Houston expansion. The foundation's Oyster Shell Recycling Program had a record-breaking year in 2022, having recycled a total of 242 tons of shell, the most recycled since the program began in 2011! The Houston expansion helped increase this year's overall total by 104 tons.

Our Oyster Shell Recycling Program promotes a sustainable Eastern oyster population by returning shucked oyster shells from local restaurants back to Galveston Bay to restore native oyster habitat. The Oyster Shell Recycling Program preserves a valuable resource while providing partnership opportunities and hands-on volunteer opportunities for schools, Scouts, and other groups seeking community service and research. By returning shucked oyster shells to Galveston Bay, the Galveston Bay Foundation is working to ensure a healthy oyster population for all to enjoy!

Managing this program since 2011, the Galveston Bay Foundation has collected over 1,493 tons (2.9 million pounds) of oyster shells to date. More than half of these recycled shells have been incorporated in oyster reef restoration projects, and the remaining shells will be returned to the bay in the next three to five years. Galveston Bay Foundation is a nonprofit organization established in 1987 to preserve and protect Galveston Bay as a healthy and productive place for generations to come.
